Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Stamp: Cutest Halloween (156480)

Die Cutting: All Dressed Up Dies (151665), Frightful Tags Dies (156492)

Designer Series Paper: Cute Halloween (151665), Black Glitter Paper (153518)

Punch: Halloween Punch (156482)

Cardstock: Basic Gray (121044)

Ink: Basic Gray (149165)

Ribbon & Twine: Metallic Mesh Ribbon (153550), Linen Thread (104199)

Misc: Tombstone Treat Boxes (156486), Cute Stars Sequins (156484), Rhinestone Jewels (144220)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (138995), Dimensionals (104430), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Bone Folder (102300), Simply Scored (122334), Mini Stampin Cut & Emboss (150673)

Non-Stampin Up items: Licorice Stick, 1x8 Clear Cello Tube Bag, PSL Sachet

Cut a piece of cardstock to measure 11" x 3"



Put into your scoring tool with a long edge along the top and score at 3 3/4" and 4"



Fold along those score lines and press firmly with a bone folder to make nice crisp folds



Take a Tombstone Treat Box panel



And carefully tear away the top tombstone shaped piece – use your paper trimmer to trim away those bottom feet pieces so you are left with nice straight edges both sides



Use strong adhesive tape to adhere this to the large back panel of your cardstock



Cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 3" x 3 1/2" and adhere to the smaller front panel – now your box is ready to decorate as wished!



To make the broom – cut a piece of patterned paper to measure 12" x 2 1/2" - place into your scoring tool (with a short edge along the top) and make 2 score lines – one at 1/2" and the second at 1"



Use a pair of fringe scissors or regular scissors and make cuts up to the intersecting line



Flip around and do the same to the other side



Turn over and place a length of very sticky tape to the back solid strip



Put a stick of licorice into a 1" x 8" Cello Tube Bag – this will be your handle. Position one end of the paper in place and start rolling your piece of paper around it



And this is what it will look like when you are done



Wrap a piece of Linen Thread or similar twine around the solid strip and tie a box to finish. Use your fingers to gently tease and pull out the paper strips to fan them out



Now is the fun bit – assembly and decorating!

Pop your Starbucks Via sachet in place – I like to use a mini glue dot to hold it there – to secure it you can either do what I did and tie around a piece of ribbon OR you could make holes in each side with a handheld punch and thread through ribbon or twine OR you could use staples or strong tape to hold the sides together.

You can attach the broom like I did, by tying it on with ribbon or you could use glue dots - have fun making your spooky treat & enjoy!
