



### Merry Christmas Money Holder

#### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Holly Jolly Wishes (156362)
- Inks: Mint Macaron (147106)
- Cardstock: Mint Macaron (138337), Whisper White (159276)
- Designer Paper: Whimsy & Wonder 12" x 12" Specialty DSP (156329)
- Accessories: Subtle Shimmer Sequins (156407)
- Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Stampin' Cut & Emboss Machine (149653), Layering Circle Dies (151770), Detailed Trio Punch (146320), Halloween Punch (156482), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), and Dimensionals (104430)
- Miscellaneous: Money or Check

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of Mint Macaron to 8" x 6 3/4". Score on the long side at 2 1/2" & 5 1/2". Round the two edges on one end using the Detailed Trio Punch. Cut a piece of the Whimsy & Wonder DSP (with the trees) and a coordinating piece of DSP at 6 11/16" x 2 5/16". Round the bottom corners of the Tree DSP as shown. Attach the DSP to the CS with the glue.



2. Using the Halloween Punch, punch a half circle in the coordinating flap as shown.



3. Add glue to the inside sides of the coordinating flap and fold up to make a pocket.



4. Cut a strip of Mint Macaron to 7" x 2" and a strip of the silver striped DSP to 7" x 1 13/16".



5. Wrap the piece of Mint Macaron around the envelope you have made and over lap and glue down. Glue the DSP over the Mint Macaron piece. (Making sure your overlaps will be covered by the piece with the greeting on it.)



6. Stamp the saying "Merry Christmas To You" in Mint Macaron onto a piece of Whisper White CS and cut out with the Circle die that fits best. Cut a scallop circle to match out of the Mint Macaron CS.



7. Add Dimensionals to the back of the Whisper White circle and attach to the scallop circle. Then glue it to band. Attach a few of the Subtle Shimmer Sequins to your saying piece and your Christmas Money Holder is now complete.
