



Slimline Envelopes Hello Ladybug Album

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Hello Ladybug (157693), Bundle (157699)
- Inks: Flirty Flamingo (147052), Flirty Flamingo Blends Combo Pack (154884), Memento Black (132708)
- Cardstock: Basic Black (121045), Basic White (159276), Flirty Flamingo (141416), Daffodil Delight (119683), Pear Pizzazz (131201)
- Designer Paper: Pattern Party Host (155426), Daffodil Afternoon (158127)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Score the white slimline envelope at 4 ¼ from the bottom end. Fold and burnish with a Bone Folder.

2. Cut a piece of the diagonal paper in the Daffodil Afternoon DSP available as part of Sale-a-Bration to 4 x 3 7/8. The 4 inch side is on the top. Glue to the front leaving a small area near the inside end. Flap will be on the back part. Cover the right side of the flap (plain side) with the same paper. Line paper up near the fold. Trim away extra with snips.



3. For the front, Use the Ranunculus Dies. Cut a detailed flower from the DSP in Daffodil Afternoon. For the detailed version use the detail die and the outside of the die. Cut a solid flower from Daffodil Delight Card Stock. HINT: Try to line up the outside die in the same way on the card stock as the DSP. Matching it together will be easier. HINT: Use some of the Adhesive Sheets on the back of the DSP for the detailed flower. Punch leaves using the Ladybug Builder Punch in Pear Pizzazz. Adhere the flower and leaves. I curled the ends of the leaves using my fingers or a Bone Folder.

4. The saying is from the Hello Ladybug stamp set. Stamp with Memento Black and trim around. Glue. Punch a Ladybug body from the Basic Black CS and the Flirty Flamingo CS. Cut the head off of the Flamingo body. Stamp the dots on the of the circle that is left in Flamingo. You will need to ink the stamp that has lots of dots. Stamp one side of the circle with one side of the stamp. Ink again and repeat

with the other side. Glue the Flamingo circle to the black body. Add Wink of Stella to the black dots. You might want to let the black dry a little first. Add the ladybug to the flower.

5. Add some of the black dots from the Classic Matte Dots.

6. For the inside of the album cut two pieces from Daffodil Afternoon measuring $3 \frac{3}{4} \times 3 \frac{7}{8}$. The $3 \frac{3}{4}$ will be on the top so please check the orientation of the paper before cutting. Glue these to the inside panels.

7. Make three daisies. For each you will need to punch out three daisies from Basic White. Use a Bone Folder to curl the petals for all nine of these. The sandwich for each daisy is one layer the petals bend down, next daisy has petals bending up and glue askew. The last layer has petals bending down and is askew. Add daisies to the panels, two on the first and one on the second. Fluff. Cut centers from the same DSP used for the detailed flower on the front. Use the Canopy Dies for the circle. The Layering Circles dies could also be used. Add the centers with dimensionals.

8. Use the Tulip dies to cut 3 stems (shorter stem) and leaves (large leaves and a smaller one are available), Use Pear Pizzazz card stock. Glue in place. You may need to trim the ends of the stems and leaves along the bottom of the envelope. I did curl some of the ends of the leaves with a Bone Folder or fingers.

9. The saying is from the Hello Ladybug stamp set. Stamp in Flirty Flamingo on Basic White and trim around. Glue.

10. You will need 2 ladybugs. Punch the body from Basic Black CS. Feed your paper in from the left. Punch the wings from Flirty Flamingo CS. Feed in the paper from the right to save on paper. Stamp the dots on the wings in Memento Black. Once it dries well, add some Wink of Stella to the dots. Attach the wings with glue dots near the top and black dimensionals back on the wing. Glue completed ladybugs, one of each side.

11. For the back of the album, cut a piece of the black with dots paper from the Pattern Party Host DSP. I used the 3rd die in from the Scalloped Contours dies. Add to the center of the back of the album with black dimensionals.

12. Stamp the saying from Hello Ladybug in Memento Black on Basic White. Cut this saying apart and add to the left side of the panel. Stamp the complete ladybug stamp on white. HINT: Use your Stamparatus to make sure you get a good dark image. Fussy cut this

ladybug. Punch more Pear Pizzazz leaves using the Ladybug Builder Punch. Add all using dimensionals or glue dots.

13. Bring the flap around to the front. Tie a piece of the Black & White Gingham Ribbon measuring 21 inches around the album and tie in a bow in the front.

14. I did not add inserts in the end pieces of this project, but you certainly could. If not I might suggest that you seal the inside with Tear & Tape or Glue Dots. An insert would be great place to add a gift card!

15. You can seal the openings at each end of this project, or you could create inserts for them. It might be a great place to tuck a gift card. For this project, I kept it simple.
