Supplies:

- Stamp Sets: Calming Camellia (158117)
- Cardstock: Fresh Freesia (155613), Basic Black (121045), Basic White (159276)
- Designer Paper: Artfully Composed (157750)
- Ink: VersaMark (102283), Tuxedo Black Memento (132708), Fresh Freesia Stampin' Blends (155518), So Saffron Stampin' Blends (154905), Just Jade Stampin' Blends (153107), Stampin' Blends Color Lifter (144608)
- Tools & Accessories: Fresh Freesia 3/8" Open Weave Ribbon (155615), Baker's Twine Essentials Pack (155475), Paper Snips (103579), Stampin' Dimensionals (100430), Mini Stampin' Dimensionals (144108), Scalloped Contours Dies (155560), Heat Tool (129053), Basics Embossing Powders (155554), Mini Glue Dots (103683)

Measurements:

- Card Base: Fresh Freesia Cardstock 8-1/2" x 5-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
- Cardstock #2: Basic Black Cardstock 5-1/4" x 4".
- Designer Paper: Artfully Composed Designer Paper 5" x 3-3/4".
- Diecut: Basic White Cardstock cut with Scalloped Contours Dies that measures 4-1/2" x 3-1/8".

Instructions:

- Glue Basic Black Cardstock layer to Fresh Freesia card base.
- Wrap Fresh Freesia Open Weave Ribbon around the designer paper layer and glue ends to the back.
- Wrap the white twine below the Fresh Freesia Ribbon three times and tie into a bow at the right.
- Glue designer paper to card front.
- Stamp the large flower image to the center of the Basic White diecut layer using VersaMark Ink. Sprinkle with black embossing powder. Use the Heat Tool to melt the powder.
- Color the flowers and leaves with the Stampin' Blends markers. Outline the outside of the stamped image with thin coloring using the So Saffron Light Stampin' Blends. Use the Color Lifter to soften the edges.
- Glue scalloped layer to card front using Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Stamp the sentiment on a scrap piece of Fresh Freesia Cardstock using Tuxedo Black Memento Ink. Hand-cut with Paper Snips close to the lettering and separate into two lines. Glue to card front using Mini Stampin' Dimensionals.
- Create a knot with the ribbon and trim the ends at an angle. Glue to the bottom of the branch using Mini Glue Dots.
