Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Cardstock: Real Red (102482), Basic White (166780), Night Of Navy (100867)
- Accessories: Various Ribbon and Twine

- Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392), Paper Snips (103579), (Discontinued List) Sweetest Star Punch (164097), Tear & Tape (154031), Multipurpose Liquid Glue (110755), White Gel Pen (166642), Non SU Hot Glue Gun, Scan & Cut, Star Punches or Dies
- Miscellaneous:

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut a piece of Real Red CS to 10" x 8 1/2". On the short side score at 1/2", 2 1/2", 4 1/2", 6 1/2". Turn a quarter turn and score at 7 1/2" and 9 1/2". Trim as shown in the picture.



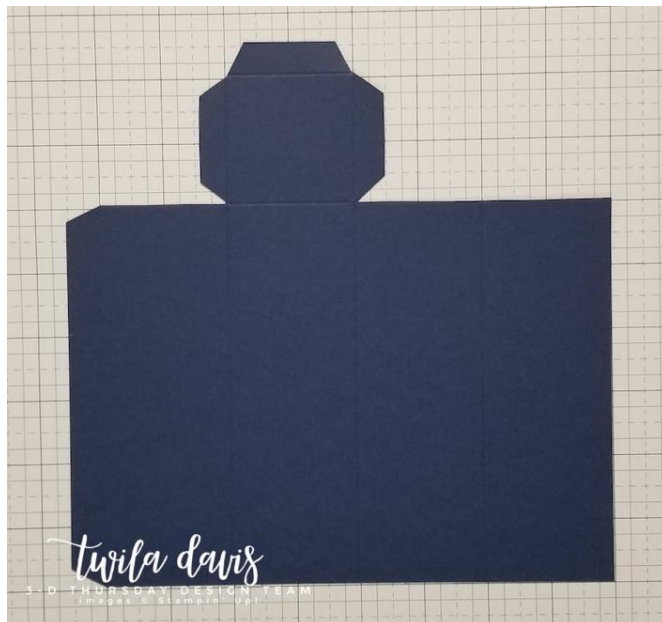
2. Using your Paper Snips and pierce a hole in the middle of the top. Cut a 3" piece of 3/8" twine and tie a knot in one end of the twine. Poke the twine up through the hole. Keep in place with hot glue. Add Tear & Tape as shown.



3. Put the box together. Cut (5) 8 1/2" x 13/16" Basic White Strips. Score at 2", 4", 6" & 8". Glue evenly spaced onto the red box, starting with the top and bottom strips. (Strips will not fit perfectly, so play around with them a bit.)



4. Using Night Of Navy CS cut a piece to 8 1/2" x 8 1/2". Score at 1/2", 2 1/2", 4 1/2", 6 1/2". Turn a quarter turn and score @ 6" & 8". Trim as shown in Step 1 and follow Step 2 again. Add some stars as shown. 1/2" & 3/4" used here made with the Scan & Cut.



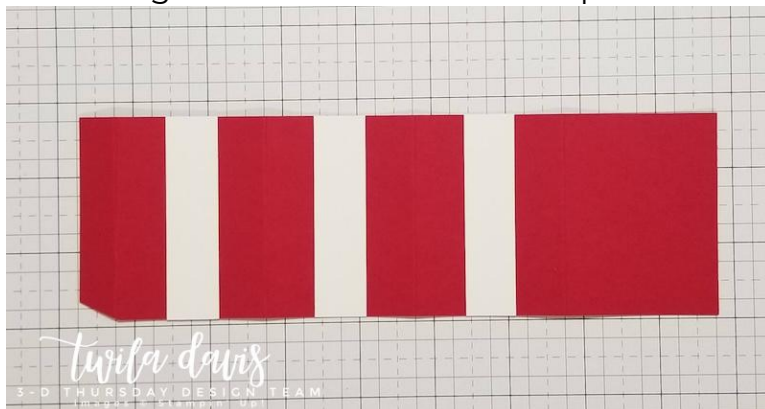
5. Assemble the box.



6. Cut a piece of Night Of Navy CS to 7" x 8 1/2". On the long side score at 1/2", 2 1/2", 4 1/2", 6 1/2". Turn a quarter turn and score at 4 1/2" & 6 1/2". Trim as shown in Step 1 and follow directions from Step 2.



7. Cut a piece of Real Red to 8 1/2" x 2 5/8". Score at 1/2", 2 1/2", 4 1/2", 6 1/2". Trim the bottom edge of the 1/2" flap at an angle. Cut (3) 2 5/8" x 13/16" strips of Basic White and glue them to the Real Red piece as shown.



8. Assemble the box and glue the red piece to the bottom section of it. Die cut or punch out (3) 1 ¼” stars and glue them above the 3 stripes.



9. Butt the boxes up together making sure the dies without stars are to the inside. Trim the wicks. Cut some pieces of matching ribbon to 32” and wrap around all of them and tie in a bow to the center. Optional - Punch out a Real Red Star using the Sweetest Star Punch. (Trim it down to be more of a pointed star.) Using the White Gel Pen write a greeting on the star. Attach star with adhesive to the middle box under the bow. Your project is now complete.
