Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps: Banner Sayings (167044) or Bundled (167051)
- Inks: Strawberry Slush (165749)
- Cardstock: Misty Moonlight(153081); Basic White (166780)
- Designer Paper: Waterside Retreat (167920); Homemade Sweetness (167467)

- Accessories: Misty Moonlight & White ¼” Ribbon (165276); Rhinestone Basic Jewels (144220)
- Tools: Stampin’ Cut & Emboss Machine (149653); Simply Scored Scoring Tool (122334); Hope Love & Joy Dies (166857); Scalloped Blooms Dies (167646) Banner Sayings Punch (167050) or Bundled (167051)
- Miscellaneous: Multipurpose Glue (110755); Bone Folder (102300); Stampin’ Dimensionals (104430); hole punch

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut the largest scallop circle from Misty Moonlight cardstock and the second largest scallop circle from the Waterside Retreat DSP.



2. Glue the designer paper scalloped circle to the Misty Moonlight piece of cardstock with Multipurpose Glue then score it at 1 ¾” and 3” (making sure the stripes are going the direction you want them to go. Burnish the score lines with the Bone Folder.



3. Cut the stars using the Hope Love & Joy Dies from Basic White cardstock and the Homemade Sweetness DSP. Attach them to the treat holder with Stampin' Dimensionals.



- Stamp the sentiment onto Basic White cardstock using Strawberry Slush ink and punch it out with the Banner Sayings Punch. Attach it under the stars with Stampin' Dimensionals. Add the Basic Jewel Rhinestones. Punch a whole at the center top (on both sides), add your candy, I used mini Hershey bars and tie it closed with the Moonlight & White ribbon.
