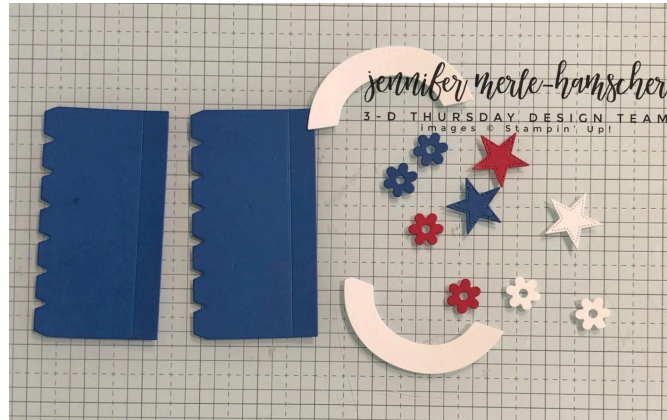

### Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Stamps:
- Inks:
- Cardstock: Blueberry Bushel (146968), Real Red (102482) and Basic White (166780)
- Designer Paper:
- Accessories: Sunset Sparkle Sequins (167785)
- Tools: Playful Packaging Dies (167599)
- Miscellaneous: Candy

## INSTRUCTIONS:



You will need two each of Basic White Thick, Real Red and Blueberry Bushel cardstock. You will want to decide if you are doing stars or flowers.



Score along the first and last 'picket' of the die. The bottom is already scored.

Cut the one section off, as shown, and wedge the other. You will repeat this exactly on the second piece.



On the little wedged side flaps add glue to the corner and fold to create one half of the 'bag'. Repeat on the second piece. Add glue to the bottom of **one** piece (I almost added to the second you can see my glue in this photo). Join the two sections. Leaving the side flaps as your last step to adhere together. I lined up the pickets to be sure it was square.



Using snips cut just a small sliver off of the two handles. This will make it easier to tuck them inside and adhere.



Decorate using your choice of stars or flowers.  
Embellish as desired with sequins.  
You can fit two Mini Ghardelli's or one Peppermint Patty inside
