SUPPLIES:

- **Stamps:** Pretty Poinsettia
- **Inks:** Peaceful Pine, Real Red Light Stampin' Blends
- **Cardstock:** Thick Basic White, Basic White, Peaceful Pine, Soft Sea Foam, Real Red
- **Designer Paper:** A Stitched Season
- **Tools & Accessories:** Pretty Poinsettia Dies, 2" Circle Punch, Stampin' Dimensionals, Paper Snips

Directions:

- **Card Base:** Thick Basic White Cardstock 8-1/2 x 5-1/2. Score and fold at 4-1/4.
- **Layer 2:** A Stitched Season Designer Paper 5-1/2 x 2-1/2. Glue to card base.
- **Layer 3:** Peaceful Pine Cardstock 3-1/4 x 3-1/4. Glue to card front 1" from the left with Stampin' Dimensionals.
- **Layer 4:** Soft Sea Foam Cardstock 3 x 3. Glue to peaceful pine layer.
- **Poinsettia:** Follow these steps:
 - Real Red Cardstock cut with the two poinsettia dies.
 - Glue the two layers together and glue to soft sea foam layer at the bottom left corner with Stampin' Dimensionals.
 - Peaceful Pine Cardstock cut with the same smaller poinsettia die. Cut the petals apart with Paper Snips.
 - Tuck and glue the leaves under the flower flat.
 - Basic White Cardstock cut with the flower centers. Glue both layers to the center of the flower flat.
- **Sentiment:** Stamp the sentiment on Basic White Cardstock with Peaceful Pine Ink. Color the wording with Stampin' Blends. Cut with the 2" Circle Punch and glue to the right of the poinsettia.
- **Stamp around the poinsettia** with the small dotted image and Soft Sea Foam Ink.
