



Red, White & Blue Pinwheel Bag

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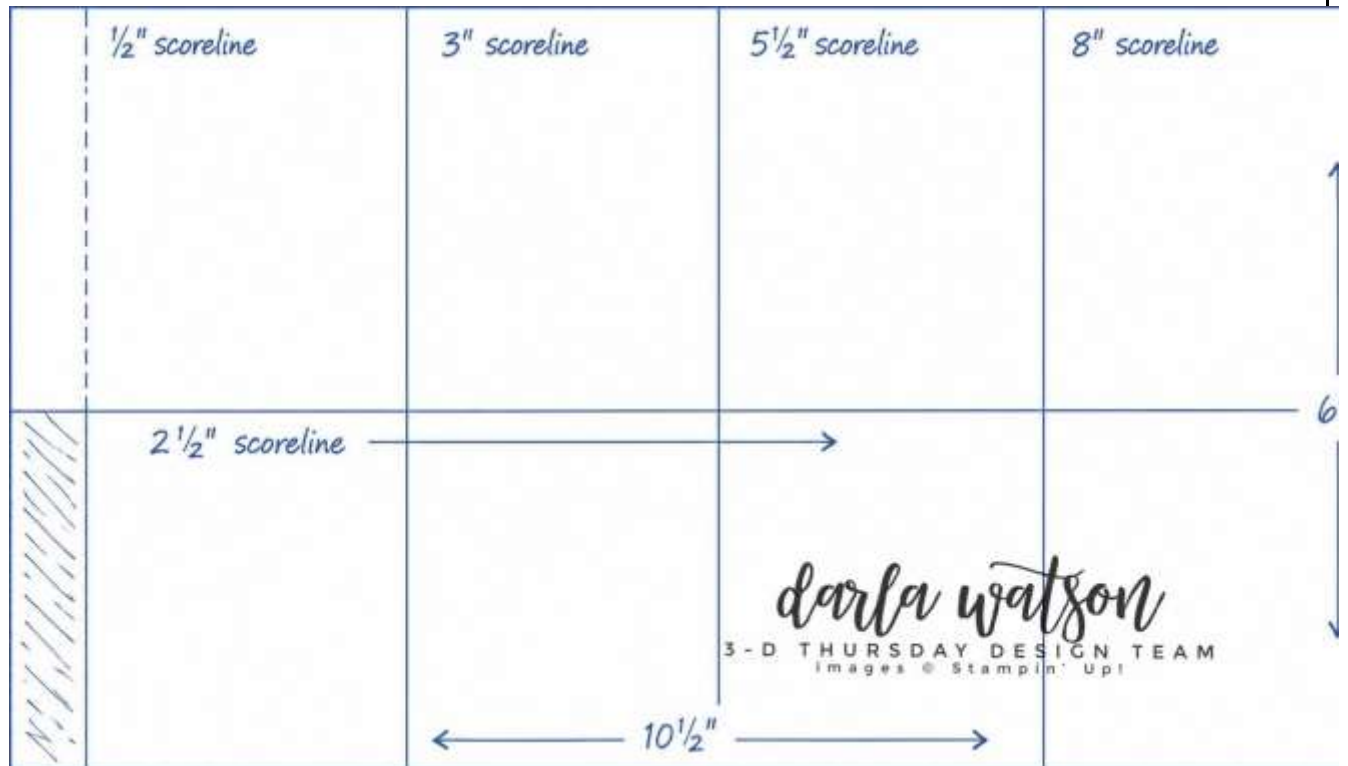
Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

- Designer Paper: Regals Painted 12 x 12 (167757)
- Accessories: Adhesive Backed Mini Christmas Buttons (168234)

- Tools: Paper Trimmer (152392); Simply Scored (122334); Detail Scissors (170902)
- Miscellaneous: Mini Glue Dots (103683); Tear & Tape (154031); Velcro Dots (Amazon)

INSTRUCTIONS:

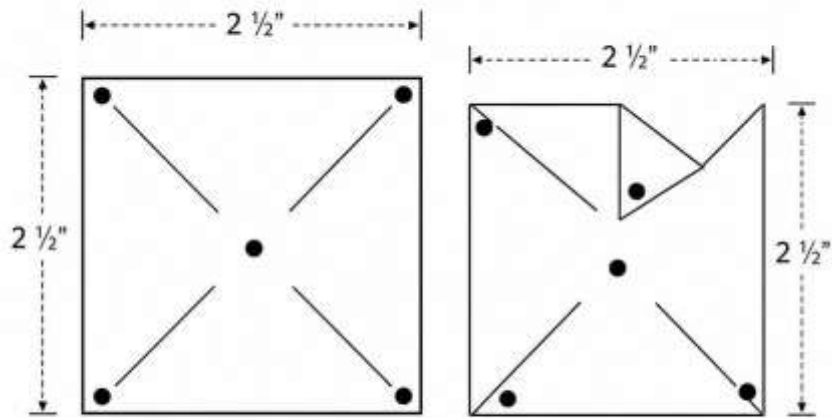
1. Cut a striped, Blueberry Bushel piece of DSP to 6" x 10 1/2". Score at 1/2", 3", 5 1/2" and 8" in the landscape position. Turn and score at 2 1/2" in the portrait Position. Cut the bottom left corner completely away (this is the portion with slashes in the photo) then cut on each of the other score lines up to the 2 1/2" score line.



Fold and adhere box with Tear & Tape.

2. Cut a 2 ½" x 2 ½" piece of the Cherry Cobbler polka dotted dsp. Cut at each corner towards the middle (not going all the way). Fold corners in adhering with a Mini Glue Dot.

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3-D THURSDAY DESIGN TEAM
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Cut and fold all 4 corners.
Then attach in the center with adhesive.
(Glue dot, hot glue, etc.)



3. Cut a 2 1/2" x 3" piece of the Cherry Cobbler polka dotted dsp scoring it a 1 1/2" on the 3" side. Attach it to the back of the bag with Tear & Tape then to the front with a Velcro dot.



4. Attach a Christmas Button to the center of the pinwheel and then the pinwheel to the front of the bag with Mini Glue Dots.
