



SPOOKTACULAR HERSHEY BAR TREAT

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Stampin' Up! Supplies Used:

Cardstocks: Basic White (166780)

Designer Series Paper: Spooktacular 6x6 (168219)

Ribbon & Twine: Black Iridescent Ribbon (168181), Essentials Baker's Twine (155475)

Die: Filled with Sweetness (167474)

Ink: Old Olive (147090)

Embellishments: Dewdrops (167748), Moody Palette Glossy Dots (167180), Adhesive Backed Bats & Ghosts (168180)

Adhesives: Stampin' Seal (152813), Tear & Tape (154031)

Misc: Hershey Bar 1.55 oz

Take a sheet of paper from Spooktacular DSP - you can choose from Frankenstein, Dracula, Jack O Lantern or Skeleton - you get 12 sheets of each character in this pack!



Trim 1/4" off the top and 1/4" off of the bottom



Take a Hershey Bar or similar sized at 1.55 oz



And wrap around the bar pushing firmly on the creases, making sure the face is centered on the front



Place a strip of strong adhesive tape on one of the long edges



Remove the backing tape and fold securely in place



And now it's ready for embellishing!
